



The Forest School Leader (Kelly Browne) and Newer team member Sarah Sheppard are both First Aiders. Ruth Pixley is the designated person.

Ruth is responsible for ensuring the first aid kit is adequately stocked according to the requirements, clean and in date

Sarah is qualified in First Aid necessary for forest school, Kelly Browne is qualified in First Aid necessary for Forest School and Paediatric First Aid

Sterile items are kept sealed and once used discarded. The first Aid Kit is located in the Forest School shed and all staff are aware of it's location. Accident/Incident forms will be completed if first aid is administered.

Consent & Medical declaration

We have a strict policy on gaining consent for medical information from attendee's parents/carers before commencing sessions at Glastonbury Forest School. These are discussed with Kelly Browne and then detailed on the parent/carer form by the parent/carer.

It requests personal information such as name, DOB, address, Emergency contact details, Other information pertaining to individual needs for the child which includes, allergies, medical needs, disabilities, neurodiversity, medication, any other specific information the parent/carer feels would be helpful for us to know in supporting their child.
